Seventeen participants arrived in good spirits and the match started on time at 9:30am. The match course comprised 9 lanes, eight with 3 targets each (including a challenging, 3-target kneeling lane) and a single standing lane of 2 targets. The average target distance was 29.9yds and the average KZ size was .99in for a 33.6 Troyer. The total score possible was 52.



Mike Vredenburg (not pictured) put in a stellar performance with the match high score of 48/52 in Open PCP (92.3%), shooting 5/6 kneelers in the process. Kevin Enzian and Bob Dye tied with 45/52 each in Hunter PCP, with Kevin winning the shoot off. David Alsup won the WFTF PCP class with 44/52. And Jeff Cloud posted top score of 35/52 in Hunter Piston.
